

# AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE ENGINEER - B1 AME & LAME (Multiple Positions)

## Overview

- Ensuring the ongoing serviceability and presentation of aircraft on a daily basis, carry out scheduled and unscheduled maintenance
- Researching requirements for upcoming maintenance to ensure availability of parts
- Testing of equipment and tooling
- Rectifications of defects away from base
- Contributing to the safety and quality managements system
- Undertaking corrective rectification of aircraft systems
- Completing scheduled aircraft maintenance
- Completing primary line maintenance activities
